ENTRY LIMITS: TDX-There are 6 tracks offered with 2 tracks set aside for test workers as set by AKC tracking regulations, Chapter 1, section 17d.

DRAWING FOR ACCEPTANCE INTO THE TEST: The drawing will be held at O'Charley's Restaurant, 1242 S. Kirkwood, St Louis, MO on Thursday, February 28, 2019 at 8pm to determine which entrants will participate in the test and the position of excess entrants on the Alternate List. There will be two drawings – the first draw will be for past test workers. Preference will be given to entrants who have not earned the title of TDX. All entrants will be advised by email, if such address has been provided, on March 1, 2019 or by USPS if no email has been provided.

DRAWING FOR RUNNING ORDER OF TRACKS: The draw will be held at 9:30am at the test headquarters at the Sullivan Fairgrounds.

REFUNDS: Entry fees will be refunded to Alternates who decline to be placed on the Alternate List and to Alternates who do not participate in the test. Entry fees will NOT be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the test date unless an Alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.

RETURNED CHECKS: There will be a \$25.00 charge for any checks returned.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a tracking test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all of the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Gateway Tracking Club assumes no responsibility for any personal injury; death of any person; theft, loss or damage of personal property; theft, injury or death of any animal while at this test site or while in transit to/from the site.

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING USE OF TEST SITE: Permission to use properties in/around Sullivan MO is for this tracking test only. Exhibitors wanting to practice at the site must secure their own permission from the Parks and Recreation Department or the owner of the private property. Practicing at the site within 3 days of the test is prohibited. All dogs must be on lead at all times. We ask you to use the dedicated exercise area when possible and always clean up your dog's waste.

DIRECTIONS TO TEST HEADQUARTERS

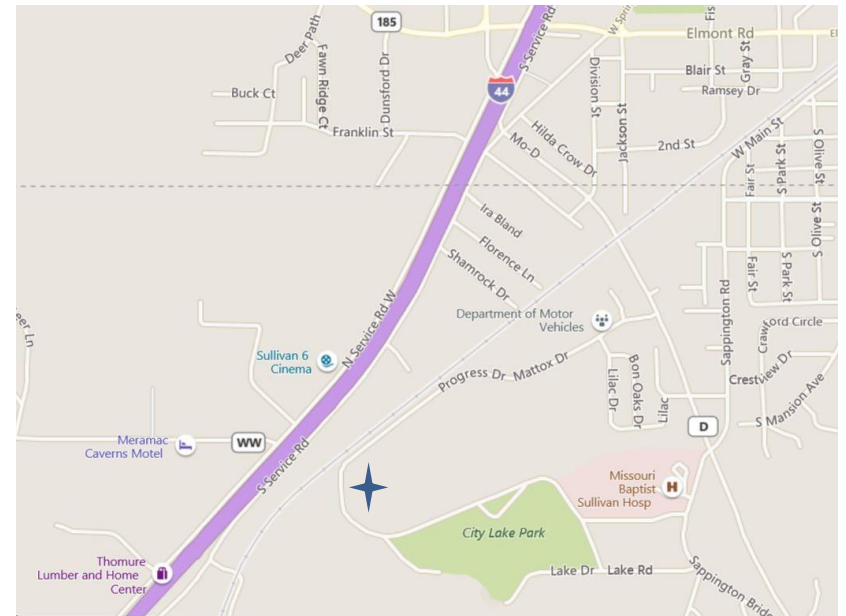
FROM THE EAST: Take I-44 West to MO-D (exit 225) toward Sullivan MO and follow MO-D. Then ***

FROM THE WEST: Take I-44 East to MO-D (exit 225) toward St Louis MO and follow MO-D. Then ***

FROM THE NORTH: Take I-55 South crossing into Missouri. Merge onto I-55S via exit 40C toward I-44 West. Merge onto I-44 West via Exit 207 toward Tulsa. Take MO-D (Exit 225) toward Sullivan, MO. Follow MO-D, then ***

FROM THE SOUTH: Take I-55 North crossing into Missouri. Merge onto I-270 North via Exit 196 toward Kansas City. Merge onto I-44 West via Exit 5B toward Tulsa. Take MO-D (Exit 225) toward Sullivan, MO. Follow MO-D then ***

***: Turn onto Progress Drive into the Fairground. This road will lead to the Headquarters building  at the back of the fairground. Please observe parking signs.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
